The word for this month is preparation. Proper preparations are vital and without them everything turns to cha-Often times in what for OS. most is a hectic season of Christmas, can be heard the question, Are you all ready for Christmas? At home there are so many preparations that must be made: shopping, decorations, cooking, and calendar coordination just to make sure nothing slips by the wayside!

At church it seems there are so many preparations to be made as well. After all there is cantata music to rehearse, social's to plan, toys to buy for John 3:16 Center, decorations to put in place, our Nativity Scene to decorate, regular and special worship and mission opportunities for which to ready ourselves, and so much more.

Yet there is an extreme danger in all this busyness of preparation and all the things that demand our attention. Amid all the preparations you make to avoid the chaos. take the necessary time in your private meditations to daily prepare your hearts to worship the Savior born in Bethlehem. Perhaps you'll want to find an Advent devotion to focus. Some good ones are avail-(http://d365.org/ able. devotions) or the ones in the literature provided for you at church and many more options so readily available. Or perhaps take time to slowly and meditatively read through the Biblical texts that focus on the coming of Christ and His birth. (Isaiah 9:2 - 7; Matthew 1:18 -25, Luke 1 & 2; John 1) You might focus on each of the Biblical characters and imagine their fears, their joys, their worries and the many varying emotions as the birth story happened before their eyes. Read and meditate seeking to know Christ in a deeper way and allow Him to speak to your heart.

In addition, let me encourage you not to forget any of the special opportunities for Christmas worship that are being prepared for your spiritual en-This richment. newsletter names those dates you'll want to put on your calendar. I also invite you to begin to pray for each of them and those involved in participating and leading. Pray that these will be special times of worship, fellowship and an opportunity for spiritual growth and renewal. I encourage you to be present. And as always, be sure to invite others to join with us in these special times.

In all of this preparation, please remember that my prayer and Christmas wish for each of you is for you to grow in spiritual wisdom and in favor with God and one another! I look forward to celebrating the birth of our Savior this month!
