VBS is a community event that is sponsored by the Lake Gaston Charge-United Methodist Churches, Littleton Baptist Church, Littleton Presbyterian Church, and Lakeside Lutheran Church. The 2016 Community VBS will be held at Littleton United Methodist Church and Littleton Baptist Church. Both churches are located at the intersection of Main St. and Mosby Ave in downtown Littleton. **Community VBS is open at no cost to ALL children – no church affiliation is required.** We will also be offering an optional free lunch that will be served from 12:15 – 1:00 PM daily.

The theme this year is **Submerged**: **finding truth below the surface**. Our theme verse is "Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my concerns. See if there is any offensive way in me; lead me in the everlasting way." Psalm 139:23-24. As children and youth are submerged in God's Word, they will discover that Jesus saw people differently.
