We studied key passages of Jesus with his disciples beside and upon the sea of Galilee as he called them to be his devoted followers. The first day we learned a memory passage from Isaiah 43:1. "I have called you by name, you are mine!" Even as we began to know the 35 children by name as they wore their fancy nametags, our leaders found joy in discovering the unique and special creations of God they were created to be and become. As pastor, these children restored hope about the future of God's mission in our world.

These children experienced the joy of worship as they sang songs about God's amazing grace. One favorite of the children was the song and motions to "He's Big." The lyrics say it all about God.

"He's big on grace, He's big on mercy. He's big in might and majesty. He's big, so big, but yet my God still knows my name and proclaims He's big on me.

As lead pastor of this year's VBS I found great joy in hearing the children recite the Bible verses they'd learned and were working to apply to their lives as they learned more and more about God through crafts and music and Bible stories and dramas, and lessons, and recreation and worship. I pray we'll all have such enthusiasm for learning and serving our "great big God."

I celebrate the fact that our VBS, though fewer in number that in some years previous, represented a wide spectrum of children from our community and beyond. And they listened with all ears when they were spoken too. They played hard, laughed hard, sang loud, and were very obedient children.

I, along with Kevin from the Littleton Presbyterian Church were able to plan, lead and participate in this year's modern day application dramas. Thanks Carly, Mary Beth, and Abigail. You were wonderful and a good example for our children!

And our adult volunteers were awesome too. Arriving early each day filled with energy and enthusiasm (well energy weakened as the days went on), but it never stopped the 100 % + effort to love and care and teach our children. I am so grateful for the participation from LBC and I thank each and everyone of you who committed yourselves to this important educational opportunity.

I left VBS the last day feeling that our children had taken home with them what we desired them to receive and excited that the seeds planted will be sprouting forth in many directions in the days, months and years henceforth.
